At present, in Italy the University Sector is made up of 89 University Institutions which are classified in:

- 58 State universities
- 17 non-State universities (legally recognized by the State)
- 2 universities for foreigners
- 6 higher schools specialized in postgraduate university studies
- 6 telematic universities

According to the Ministerial Decree 270/2004, which rules the latest reform of the University system, State Universities issue, at the end of each relevant study course, the following titles:

- Laurea (L) [1st cycle degree]; 3 years; 180 credits
- Laurea Magistrale (LM) [2nd cycle degree]; 2 years; 120 credits
- Diploma di Specializzazione (DS, Specialization Degree)
- Dottorato di Ricerca (DR, Research Doctorate); minimum 3 years
- Master di primo e secondo livello (1st and 2nd level University Masters)

Credits (one credit is usually the equivalent of 25 hours of study) indicate the workload required for a student with adequate initial preparation to acquire the knowledge and skills envisaged by the course syllabus. These hours include both classroom activities (lectures, practice, seminars), individual study and other training activities like internships etc. The average yearly workload required for a full-time student has been set to 60 credits. Credits are earned by passing the final examination or by successfully completing other forms of assessment. They do not replace grades. The maximum final university degree grade is 110/110. Exceptional students may be awarded a degree grade of 110/110 cum laude. Classes may be held in semesters or annually, depending on the Faculties: 1st semester from mid/last week of February to the end of July. Lectures usually finish before the end of the term to provide students with time for the exam period. Exams are held on different dates during the academic year. All lectures and exams are held in Italian.

The University of Bari, one the 58 State universities, was founded in 1925 and is attended today by about 60.000 students, has 15 faculties across the Bari, Brindisi, and Taranto campuses and offers 125 degree programs (Bachelor's and Doctoral degrees).

The University of Bari has many complexes, the main are the following:

• Palazzo Ateneo, in the city centre, where all the administrative offices, the rector's office and the faculties of Letters and Education are based

- the University Campus, more peripheral, where all the scientific faculties are based
- Policlinico, where the faculty of Medicine and Surgery is based

Students can consult the appendix in order to see where the other university complexes are located.

In this guide the foreign reader will be able to have a general overlook of all the centres and services the University of Bari offers his students, the bachelor's degrees and the professional opportunities offered by the faculties, the intense international exchange activity regarding students and teachers and much more which can be found on the website *uniba.it*.

International cooperation

The University of Bari has always been characterized by a strong international vocation and now, more than ever, internationalization is considered as one of its primary policies. The international activities of the University of Bari can be grouped under the following main headings:

- Promotion of the International Inter-University Cooperation Conventions aimed at planning collaborative scientific research
- Promotion of the International Inter-University Conventions aimed at creating international joint study courses
- Participation in the Research and Training Programmes of the European Union and other Institutions (MAE, MIUR, CRUI, etc.)
- Mobility within the LLP/Erasmus Programme
- Mobility within the Fulbright Programme

Foreign students

Community and non-community foreign students, with a regular residence permit are admitted to this University under the same guidelines used for Italian students. For students with dual nationality one of which is Italian, the Italian nationality is valid. Students can only apply to University if they have valid secondary school qualifications.

Non-community students, without a residence permit, can be admitted within the limits of available positions, upon successfully passing the Italian language test. They must bring a pre-enrollment form (Modello A) to the Italian consular post in their country of origin, in which the specific Bachelor's Degree Course and the chosen University are indicated. The following documents must be included with the application form:

a) original copy of secondary school qualifications of at least 12 years of education, or a legally validated substitute certificate;

b) document which certifies the passing of an academic competence test to access higher education in their home universities;

c) document which certifies partial or completed academic course of study, in cases where the number of secondary school years is less than 12;

d) two passport photos (one authenticated by the Italian consular post of the country of origin).

If foreign students already have a University Degree or have passed a certain number of exams in their country and want to validate them, a detailed description of the mentioned exams must be included in the application form. For students from countries which have subscribed to the Aja Convention of October 5 1961, the documents must have the "Apostille" stamp, postmarked by the authorized local authorities. All documents written in foreign languages must have a legally validated translation into Italian, marked by the Italian consular post.

Foreign students needing to take the Italian language examination (usually on early September) must bring their passport and student Visa, together with their residence permit or a proof of application for residency.

Students who do not pass the Italian language examination cannot take other aptitude or competitive examinations.

Erasmus incoming students

Registration and admission

For admission, foreign students have to fill in both the application form and the learning agreement and return them only on line to the Erasmus Office, no later than: May 20th (starting from March 10th) first semester and for the whole academic year, November 20th (starting from September 1st) second semester. After that, students are asked to print the forms and send them by post, with the signatures of the Departmental and Institutional Coordinators, no later than May 30th – first semester and for the whole academic year, November 30th – second semester to the following address: Università degli Studi di Bari Aldo Moro, Servizio Archivistico di Ateneo, Settore I, Protocollo, Piazza Umberto I, 1, 70121 Bari (Italia). The application form will be accepted only if the documents are signed by the departmental and institutional coordinators of the home university. The official acceptance letter will be sent to the students only after reception of the duly signed application.

At the beginning of the academic year, or of the second semester, students are registered temporarily, for one or two semesters, at the Erasmus Office.

After registration, students receive:

- a student's record book
- five certificates demonstrating their Erasmus status during their study period

They can be used for some facilities and services destined to Erasmus students.

At the end of their study period, Erasmus students will receive the following documents:

- certificate of attendance
- transcript of records
- all other documents they may need when back to their home institution (special forms and/or standardised certificates/transcript of records) will be duly signed and stamped by our University

Erasmus students will have to hand back the following documents, before their departure:

- student's record book
- copy of the Learning Agreement duly signed by the Institutional and Departmental Coordinators of both Universities
- copy of Changes to the Learning Agreement duly signed by the Institutional and Departmental Coordinators of both universities

The residence permit

Students belonging to EU are not obliged to get their residence permit. Students coming from countries not included in the EU need to get a residence permit from the police headquarters. They are obliged to register, no later than eight days after their arrival, according to the Immigration Law. To obtain the release of the residence permit, students are asked to fill in a form and provide the following documents:

- four ID photos
- a 14.62 € tax stamp (for students coming from countries not included in the EU)
- a photocopy of identity card or passport
- a copy of the documentation concerning their study period they gave to the Italian Consulate of their country to obtain a visa to study abroad (for students coming from countries not included in the EU, such as Middle Eastern Europe)
- a proof of accommodation
- a proof of the amount of the grant
- a health care form

National civil service

In 2008, the University of Bari obtained 1st class accreditation in the Regional Registry of Civil Service. In 2009 the Office of the Prime Minister – National Office of Civil Service, approved two projects presented by the University of Bari:

- the "Athena" project, which aims to increase and improve the usability of services offered by the university libraries and museums, for a total of 31 volunteers
- the "Asclepius" project which aims to guarantee full social integration and to break down the barriers to learning for differently-abled students through the availability of special services and the involvement of adequately trained personnel, for a total of 9 volunteers

Volunteers work 30 hours per week, for a total of 1400 hours yearly, and receive a salary of \in 433.89 per month from the National Office of Civil Service. For 2010 the University of Bari has confirmed its request for 1st class accreditation in the Regional Registry, and has presented new projects, including two for Civil Service abroad, Israel and Peru.

Student rights ombudsman

The Student Rights Ombudsman was instituted to safeguard and guarantee student rights which are felt to have been prejudiced by abuse, disservice or delays imputable to actions, or behaviours, even of omission, by university bodies and offices. In such cases, the Students Council or single can turn to the Student Rights Ombudsman, who in conformity with the law in force, will express an opinion and, if necessary, intervene by making a report to the appropriate bodies.

The Student Rights Ombudsman must also:

- investigate and control the development of the student-organized non-profit cultural, social and sports activities
- elaborate the criteria for the evaluation, financing and verification of the student-organized activities, after hearing the mandatory opinion of the Students Council and the Academic Senate
- advance suggestions and express opinions on situations regarding the

implementation of the student rights

• produce an annual report on his activity to the Academic Senate and the Administrative Board

The Student Rights Ombudsman public records are not binding. In conformity with the deliberations of the Academic Senate the Student Rights Ombudsman can meet the students of each faculty, upon arrangements with the faculty deans and the Student Council.

University library system

The University of Bari has its own University Library System divided into four broad scientific-disciplinary areas: biomedicine, legal-economic, scientific-technological and humanistic. The goal of these areas is to coordinate the development and organization of all the librarianship functions, as well as the development of library services for the treatment and proliferation of bibliographic information.

The University of Bari currently has:

- 11 central libraries
- 61 departmental libraries, often divided in "sections"
- 1 documentation centre

The library assets are catalogued in card indexes located in the various libraries, while 30% of the material is available on the university's electronic catalogue, OPAC (Open Access Catalogue). OPAC, the bibliographic database electronic periodicals, the SINBIP site for bibliographic researches, and more detailed information on the University Library System are all available on the website: uniba.it/ateneo/ bibliotechecentri.

Museum activities

A wide range of structures dedicated primarily to museum activities and the proliferation of scientific information is available to the university community. These include:

- *the Botanical Gardens* contains 800 plant species from around the world, a herbarium with 40,000 samples and a Seed bank that preserves over 2 million seeds, particularly plant species that risk extinction (c/o University Campus)
- the Commodities Museum gathers and stores sample of raw materials, goods, yarns, food products and equipment of interest in the field of commodities (c/o Faculty of Economics)
- the Mediterranean Citadel of Science brings together and organizes the museum patrimony related to the development of the sciences present in the University of Bari and throughout Apulia. It is divided into three theme based areas: appearance and reality; water; images, light and colours. Herbal techniques

Professional opportunities: graduates are qualified to carry out professional activities related to the production, transformation and packaging of plant medicines, parts and derivatives with nutritional health and cosmetic value, guaranteeing quality as for the laws in force. These are only a few of the activities coordinated by the aforementioned law; the course of study may also take into consideration other professions carried out by the European Union in the field of pharmaceuticals, so as to create equal occupational opportunities throughout Europe. The professions of professor of mathematical, physical and chemical sciences, professor of life and health sciences and professor of technical and scientific disciplines require an additional training course specific to teaching. The course prepares graduates for work as: chemists; chemistry researchers; pharmacologists, bacteriologists and related professions; pharmacists and related

professions; researchers, pharmaceutical technicians and related professions; researchers and pharmaceutical technicians in the chemistry and pharmaceutical sciences; professors of mathematical, physical and chemical sciences, professor of life and health sciences and professor of technical and scientific disciplines; industrial quality control technicians.

Pharmacy
