The areas of the Right to Study, Financial Aid and Student Services offer students a series of benefits and special offers to help them have the best possible university experience. The Right to Study:

- part-time student jobs within the university; up to 150 hours are available for each student
- administrative activities connected with institutional relationships with the A.DI.SU. (Regional Agency for the Right to Study); activities that promote relationships with public and private agencies to create opportunities for students.

- scholarships for the completion of the scientific training of graduates, thanks to funds originating from donations or agreements with agencies and institutions;
- study and graduation awards assigned to students and deserving young graduates, using funds from acts of generosity;
- graduation awards to the best students of each College with the consignment of the bronze University Seal by the Chancellor and the degree scroll by the appropriate College Dean during the ceremony for the inauguration of the academic year;
- graduation awards to the top graduates offered by Unicredit Banca "Antonio Sarzana;"
- financial aid for students, or special subsidies for students in serious economic difficulty;

DIFFERENTLY-ABLED STUDENT OFFICE

The University of Bari, in its aim to promote the full participation of all differently-abled students in its didactic, training and relational activities, instituted the Differently-Abled Student Services in 2000. It is staffed by the administrative personnel, and serves as a counselling centre to:

- allow these students full access to the university
- ensure their complete integration in university life
- supply them, and their families, with support and information for the resolution of any problems.

In enforcement of Law no. 17/99 in favour of differently-abled students, the following services are offered:

- didactic and specialised tutoring
- interpreting for the hearing impaired
- aids for dyslexia
- transportation and assistance
- technological aids
- monitoring of architectural barriers
- treatment of didactic materials
- counselling.

Additionally, the University of Bari has signed a programme agreement with the Italian Paralympic Committee, which includes, among other activities, collaboration in the project “Motor Activities for Differently-Abled Students” launched by the Motor and Sport Sciences degree course.

ORIENTATION AND TUTORING SERVICE

UNIVERSITY INTERSHIP SERVICE

The University of Bari supports relationships with the world of work through pre- and post-graduate internships handled by its *University Internship Service*.

This service:

- provides orientation activities for students, recent graduates and local, national and international companies, for the formalisation of agreements for training and orientation internships, so as to favour the alternation of periods of study and work as part of the learning process and to assist in choosing a profession through direct contact with the world of work;
- coordinates activities of didactic management;
- is responsible for the formalisation of collaboration agreements and other accords regarding didactics and training drawn up with public and private agencies;
- supplies professors and university structures legal administrative counselling, administrative support and collaboration, for the promotion and consolidation of relationships with public and private bodies on the local, national and international level, pertaining to didactics and training.

WEB SERVICES

On the www.uniba.it website, the following web services are available:

- *students*: this section of the site includes all the information relative to:

course offerings, orientation, services, opportunities, regulations, forms and much more;

- *Studenti@Uniba notice board*: located on the home page, the notice board displays all notices and news for students;
- *student e-mail*: upon enrolment students are assigned a username and password to access a personal e-mail address on the unibari.net domain;
- *on line office*: students can consult the data relative to their university career and enrol, make payments and deal with administrative paperwork via web. An on-line service offers assistance in resolving access problems. Additionally, it is possible to access services offered by Almalaurea;
- *wireless*: a Wi-Fi network allows students to connect to high-speed Internet with their own pc, palm pc or smartphone. The connection is available to students with access credentials (username e password) in areas covered by the signal;
- *recruitment area*: this section includes test announcements, schedules, rankings and all information relative to limited enrolment degree courses.

NATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE

In 2008, the University of Bari obtained 1st class accreditation in the Regional Registry of Civil Service. The national public competition, issued 22 June 2009 by the Office of the Prime Minister – National Office of Civil Service, approved two projects presented by the University of Bari:

- the “Athena” project, which aims to increase and improve the usability of services offered by the university libraries and museums, for a total of 31 volunteers;
- the “Asclepius” project, which aims to guarantee full social integration and to break down the barriers to learning for differently-abled students through the availability of special services and the involvement of adequately trained personnel, for a total of 9 volunteers.

Volunteers work 30 hours per week, for a total of 1400 hours yearly, and receive a salary of €433.89 per month from the National Office of Civil Service. For 2010, the University of Bari has confirmed its request for 1st class accreditation in the Regional Registry, and plans to present new projects, including one for civil service abroad.

**PSYCHOLOGICAL
COUNSELLING SERVICE**

SeCops is a service that the University of Bari has dedicated to students to meet their needs for psychological support. Interested students can request a psychological-clinical consultation, and participate in a series of weekly individual and group sessions with an assigned psychologist. The service works as follows:

**STUDENT RIGHTS
OMBUDSMAN**

The Student Rights Ombudsman was instituted to safeguard and guarantee student rights which are felt to have been prejudiced by abuse, disservice or delays imputable to actions, or behaviours, even of omission, by university bodies and offices. In such cases, the Student Council or single students can turn to the Student Rights Ombudsman, who, in conformity with the law in force, will express an opinion and, if necessary, intervene by making a report to the appropriate bodies.

STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

The European Union promotes and finances, with supplementary subsidies, a series of co-operation and exchange programmes between universities. These programmes encourage the international mobility of university students and provide scholarships and guarantee recognition of the credits accumulated during the period of study abroad. The University of Bari currently participates in the Lifelong Learning/Erasmus and Leonardo da Vinci programmes and Programma Tempus, and offers further supplementary subsidies for its students. Additionally, collaboration agreements have been signed with numerous European and non-European universities (France, Argentina, Albania, Serbia, Montenegro, Greece, etc.).

UNIVERSITY SPORT CENTRE (C.U.S.)

The University Sport Centre boosts university sport policy within the framework of the overall development of the student. The centre, in addition to the management and maintenance of sports structures, promotes various levels of courses in a wide variety of disciplines and participates in competitive university and federal sports events.

The centre offers:

- free use structures: indoor pool, outdoor pool, indoor sports arena and skating rink, and an athletics ground. It is not necessary to make reservations to use the swimming pools;
- fee-paying structures: tennis court, 5-a-side football field;
- beginning to advanced level sport courses: athletics, canoe, rowing, karate, swimming, basketball, volleyball, skating, tennis, triathlon and ultimate frisbee. University students pay a reduced fee for these courses.

University activities: annual inter-college tournaments in the following disciplines: athletics, canoe, rowing, karate, swimming, basketball, volleyball, skating, tennis, triathlon and ultimate frisbee. Students with a particular talent in the aforementioned sports can participate as representatives of the C.U.S., and upon the decision of the centre's technicians, in the National University Championships (C.N.U.) organised annually by the Italian University Sport Centre (C.U.S.I.).

Federal activities: students who demonstrate, upon the decision of the centre's technicians, the necessary level of ability and commitment can participate, at their own expense, in the competitive activity organised by the National Federations under the auspices of C.O.N.I. which the C.U.S. is affiliated with: athletics, canoe, rowing, karate, Greco-Roman and freestyle wrestling, swimming, basketball, skating and triathlon.

UNIVERSITY LANGUAGE CENTRE

The University Language Centre (CLA) is a “virtual community,” with the primary objective of teaching linguistic communication with other world citizens, as well as preparing its students to enter the local, national and European workforce. It is composed of a central centre, located at the College of Foreign Languages and Literatures, and five independent centres with on-line networking. Each laboratory has a modular system for the organisation of lessons and resources (satellite TV channels, DVD player, CD audio player, audio cassette player, etc.) and full access to all the material and infinite resources available on Internet.

CLA activities include:

- a) language teaching
- b) multimedia didactic training
- c) information technology language training
- d) basic information technology training.

The CLA is an official Cambridge ESOL Examinations centre offering international language certification.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY SYSTEM

The University of Bari has its own “University Library System,” divided into four broad scientific-disciplinary areas: biomedicine, legal-economic, scientific-technological, and humanistic. The goal of these areas is to coordinate the development and organisation of all the librarianship functions, as well as the development of library services for the treatment and proliferation of bibliographic information.

The University of Bari currently has:

- 11 central libraries
- 61 departmental libraries, often divided in “sections”
- 1 documentation centre.

The library assets are catalogued in card indexes located in the various libraries, while 30% of the material is available on the university’s electronic catalogue, OPAC (OPen Access Catalogue). OPAC, the bibliographic data banks, electronic periodicals, the SINBIP site for bibliographic searches, and more detailed information on the University Library System are all available on the University of Bari website, at: www.uniba.it/ateneo/bibliotechecentri.

MUSEUM ACTIVITIES

A wide range of structures dedicated primarily to museum activities and the proliferation of scientific information is available to the university community. These include:

- **the Interdepartmental Service Centre for Scientific Museology (CISMUS)** links the university to the outside community in the coordination of all scientific museology activities and organises, upon request from the afferent structures, a programme of practical/didactic initiatives and guided tours (c/o University Campus, info@cismus.uniba.it)
- **the Museum of Zoology** contains almost a thousand zoological exhibits of Apulian, Italian and north-east African marine and land fauna (c/o University Campus)
- **the Museum of Earth Sciences** has collections of Apulian fossils, rocks and minerals, as well as important historical geological maps (c/o University Campus)
- **the Botanical Gardens** contains 800 plant species from around the world, a herbarium with 40,000 samples and a Seed Bank that preserves over 2 million seeds, particularly plant species that risk extinction (c/o University Campus)
- **the Commodities Museum** gathers and stores sample of raw materials, goods, yarns, food products and equipment of interest in the field of commodities (c/o College of Economics)
- **the Mediterranean Citadel of Science** brings together and organises the museum patrimony related to the development of the sciences present in the University of Bari and throughout Apulia. It is divided into three theme based areas: appearance and reality; water; images, light and colours. These areas host interactive exhibits and multimedia products (www.citadellamediterraneascienza.uniba.it).

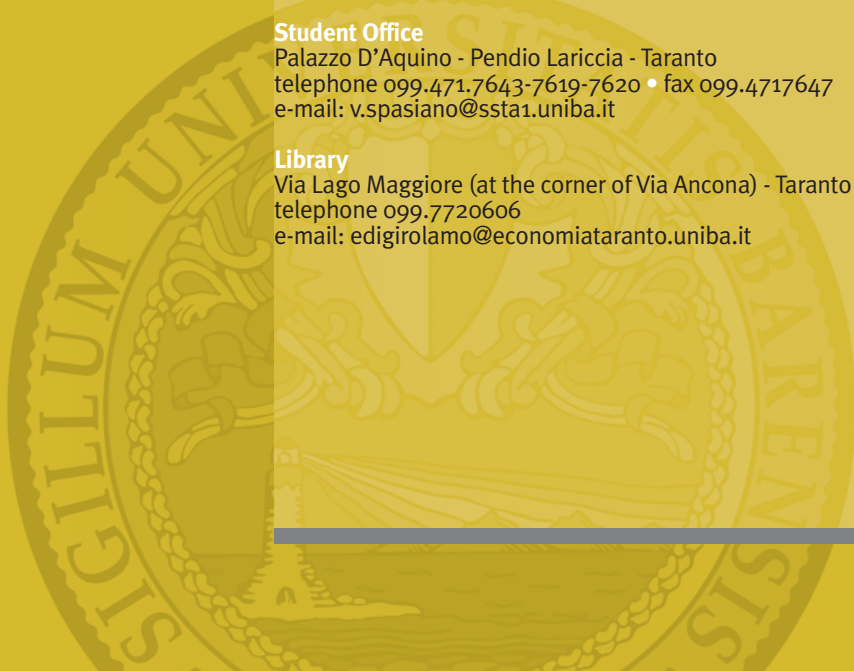

HERBAL TECHNIQUES (TE)

Professional opportunities: graduates are qualified to carry out professional activities related to the production, transformation and packaging of plant medicines, parts and derivatives with nutritional health and cosmetic value, guaranteeing quality as per the laws in force. They can work in: herbalist's shops and chemist's shops that sell over-the-counter medicines; companies that produce, distribute and import medicinal plants; companies and laboratories that extract, transform and inspect raw plant materials; food and cosmetic factories that use raw plant materials; pharmaceutical companies that produce herbal products, homeopathic products and dietary supplements made with medicinal plants; sectors that promote and publicise products made with raw plant materials; public and private structures that operate in the field of information regarding products made with plant matter. CHEMISTRY AND PHARMACEUTICAL TECHNOLOGIES (CTF)

The professions of professor of mathematical, physical and chemical sciences, professor of life and health sciences and professor of technical and scientific disci-

plines require an additional training course specific to teaching. The course prepares graduates for work as: chemists; chemistry researchers; pharmacologists, bacteriologists and related professions; pharmacists and related professions; researchers, pharmaceutical technicians and related professions; researchers and pharmaceutical technicians in the chemistry and pharmaceutical sciences; professors of mathematical, physical and chemical sciences, professor of life and health sciences and professor of technical and scientific disciplines; industrial quality control technicians.

PHARMACY (FA)

HEALTHCARE

Professional opportunities: healthcare workers in the areas of disease prevention, and healthcare promotion and education. The activities of graduates of this programme focus on the person, the family and the society. They identify healthcare needs and prioritise preventative, educational and rehabilitative actions.

NUTRITION SCIENCE

Professional opportunities: graduates work in the field of the correct application of dietary and nutritional needs, including education and collaboration in the implementation of food policies, in accordance with the law in force.

PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION / Inter-faculty programme with the Faculty of Education

Professional opportunities: healthcare workers who implement specific educational and rehabilitation projects, within a therapeutic plan designed by a multi-disciplinary team, aimed at the harmonious development of the patient with relational objectives aimed at participation in and recovery of everyday life; graduates guide the psycho-social integration or reintegration of patients in difficulty.

MEDICAL AND PHARMACEUTICAL BIOTECHNOLOGIES (limited enrolment course)

Professional opportunities: professionals in the various spheres of application of medical and pharmaceutical biotechnology; in the applicative sectors of the pharmaceutical industry in research, development and inspection of biotechnological pharmaceuticals and in the development of diagnostics; in the cosmetic industry and biotechnology research centres. The course also covers the integration of the technical-scientific aspects with the legal aspects of regulation and economic aspects which qualify graduates to work in various biotechnological sectors, such as the pharmaceutical industry, environmental bioindustry, fine chemistry and energetic chemistry, the food industry and the agro-food division, as well as scientific communication.

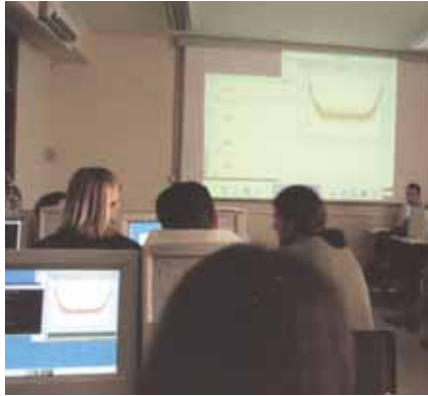
