| Contenuti di insegnamento | <p>The course aims at giving to the students a knowledge about the main tools offered by the critical geopolitics in order to read the geopolitical discourses and political praxis. In particular, starting from the division between a practical, an intellectual and a political geopolitics, the lessons will prepare the students to read and comment the different meanings of political and intellectual discourses about international powers and dangers, in order to define the scopes of the main political interpretations of political events. In particular, the realistic geopolitical view, according to which politics depends on material resources and on the differences between mentalities and civilisations will be read itself as the political and academic discourse, useful in order to legitimate a power and to mobilise the masses.</p> <p>The course will be divided into five parts:</p> <p>1. Introduction: Geopolitics as an applied science. Contents and definitions of geopolitics, Geopolitics between geography and politics. The use of geopolitics from the colonial wars to the "clash of civilisations".</p> |
