Assessment and feedback	
Mode of assessment of learning	Oral exam. The student is called to demonstrate his level of preparation on the topics of the program, through the answer not less than two questions put by the examining commissioners (unless the candidate freely chooses to "withdraw" earlier)
Evaluation criteria	The student must demonstrate expository coherence and logical-systematic skills and prove to have acquired at least a sufficient "reasoned" knowledge of the course program
