	Students will be encouraged to deal with the analysis of legal texts
	(judgments, regulatory acts, etc.) in order to concretely verify the
	skills acquired during the course and any gaps in basic preparation,
	to be promptly filled.

Methods of assessment	Oral examination. The student is asked to demonstrate his level of
	preparation on the topics of the program, by answering no less than
	two questions posed by the examining commissioners (unless the
	candidate freely chooses to "retire" first).
Evaluation criteria	In order to pass the test, the candidate is required to demonstrate
	that he or she has acquired at least a sufficient "reasoned"
	knowledge of the course program. Therefore, the evaluation criteria
	also include the acquired logical-systematic, critical-argumentative
	skills, as well as, of particular importance, the quality of exposure
	and the ability to use the specialized vocabulary.
Criteria for assessment	The assessment of the learning level will take place with a final
