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Applying knowledge and understanding on:	Thanks to the discussion of philosophical texts from our philosophical and political tradition, students can learn how to study scientifically authors from different periods, paying attention to the constitution of different lexical traditions on ethical and political subjects. At the same time, through the discussion of the main texts of our philosophical tradition, students should develop the capacity of thinking critically on the main political concepts and on the parameters of evaluation of the political action in modern times. $_{\odot}$
