Expected learning outcomes	The teaching aims to provide students with an exhaustive understanding the system of appeals and special proceedings (labour procedure, summary proceedings, precautionary sentences, proceedings of separation of spouses and divorce, chambers proceedings, class actions) and of main institutions in executive proceedings.

Institutes of notable practical importance and broad implementation experience will be discussed in class, such as the appeal judgment and the other systems of appeal and proceedings before the labour courts, summary judgements, provisional and precautionary measures, debarment, separation and divorce proceedings, as well as the enforcement proceeding.
