Expected learning outcomes	<p><i>Knowledge and understanding</i>          This course aims at giving knowledge and understanding of basic notions in community psychology according to a psychosocial perspective.</p> <p><i>Applying knowledge and understanding</i>          This course will illustrate practical interventions in order to understand professional actions aimed at promoting social change.</p> <p><i>Making informed judgements and choices</i>          It aims to develop the ability of independently processing communities resources in order to identify preventive or restorative solutions for collective and individual well-being.</p> <p><i>Communicating knowledge and understanding</i>          Another aim is to promote the ability of communicating topics of community psychology by its specific language.</p> <p><i>Capacities to continue learning</i>          Learning skills consist of independently deepening theoretical</p>

	and practical contents.
Contents	This course will describe the interaction between individual and environment by specific knowledges of community social psychology: theoretical models for the analysis of community contexts and methodological tools for social intervention. So it will focus on the ecological approach to community psychology, individual and collective empowerment, sense of community, prevention and promotion of well-being, group as intervention tool, focus groups, action-research and participation, application fields of community psychology.
