<p>Expected learning outcomes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Knowledge and understanding of the main theories in general psychology and its research methods. ● Knowledge and understanding of individual, interpersonal and social psychological processes, starting from examples applied to everyday life, with a special attention to developmental age and school settings. ● Critical skills in relation to the main theories of general psychology. ● Communication abilities in introducing the main studies of general psychology, highlighting their weaknesses and adopting an adequate and relevant lexicon. ● Ability to learn new concepts and apply them transversally especially in relational learning and educational contexts, incorporating the main related theories and overcoming a common sense approach to psychological processes.
<p>Contents</p>	<p>The course wishes to provide students with an introduction to the themes of basic research and methods of general experimental psychology.
