Contenuti di insegnamento	<p>In the general part:</p> <p>We will start from the analysis of the discipline through research itineraries between the nineteenth and twentieth century's:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The fairy tale and the timeless fairy tale tools, the novel to train reading and "re-writing" (adventure novels, pink and fantasy). Some iconographic references: The illustrated books to tell children simple or complex stories with a combination of few words and many figures. - The lesson of the classics for children through the authors (Dickens, Alcott, Grimm, Salgari, Vamba, De Amicis, Perrault) <p>Literary literature through Rodari, / fantasy fiction: Lewis Carroll.</p> <p>In the special part:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the theme of the fairy tale will be deepened: with the analysis of "Cinderella", among the fairy tales more rooted in the popular imagination among children and adults. -The literature of the twentieth century with Gianni Rodari, -The idea of school through the story of the teachers and teachers and the "poetry of the school". -The theme of feelings (conflict, death, violence and love) through examples and readings, the theme of violence against women, using illustrated books, children's books and fairy tales dedicated to the theme.
