	• Communicating knowledge and understanding Through the course the student learns to communicate in oral form ideas, problems and solutions concerning the subject. The question time in class is aimed not only at sharing the problems of understanding and learning with all the students but above all it wants to stimulate the student to a confrontation in front of classmates. The seminar activity supports this goal. The stimulus activity is completed by the individual reception during which particular attention is paid to the language used by the student and to the study methodology.
	• Capacities to continue learning Through the study of sustainable business law, the student deepens his understanding of the rules and institutions of the economic reality. The comparison between legal systems is also fundamental, which allows the student to acquire an awareness of the entirety of the economic system and of the subjects that operate there. On this basis, the student will acquire skills and critical skills suitable to guarantee him further theoretical and practical insights.
