Syllabus	
Learning Objectives	The student will have to show a good knowledge of the specific topics of the course, and he will have to be aware of them. More specifically the student will be asked: Know the fundamental principles of national, EU and international law on immigration and protection of foreigners. Identify, recognize and interpret the legal issues related to the entry and the residence of foreigners in Italy as well as their expulsion.
Course prerequisites	
Contents	The regulations of immigration and the legal status of foreigners between national, EU and international law will be examined, with a focus on its sources and its historical evolution. The right to asylum, the refugee status, the stateless status and the international and subsidiary protection of the foreigners will be taught, along with the Italian citizenship, the principle of free movement of people within the European Union and EU citizenship. A specific attention will be paid to the right of entry of residence of Union citizens and their family members as well as the rights and the duties of foreigners in Italy. The evolution of Italian migration law. The entry and residence permits. Work and family reunification. Protection of parenthood and of underage people.
