Learning results	<p>At the end of the course the student must prove to have acquired:</p> <p><b>(1) Knowledge and ability of understanding:</b> to carry out interdisciplinary agreements between two epistemological fields in terms of interpretation and planning, using texts and topics of particular pedagogical interest</p> <p><b>(2) Knowledge and understanding, applied:</b> to develop the acquired knowledge to carry out targeted pedagogical interventions and to support themes useful to the educational debate.</p> <p><b>(3) Autonomy of judgment:</b> to critically rethink the learning results in order to carry out pedagogical interventions through the collection of relevant data necessary to manage and interpret the complex education-</p>

	<p>rehabilitation field.</p> <p><b>(4) Communication skills:</b> to revise the learning results according to the relational dynamics defined together with specialists in the educational sector through the formulation of ideas, problems and solutions.</p> <p><b>(5) Learning skills:</b> undertake further disciplinary and interdisciplinary investigations in order to broaden the scope of educational research with a high degree of autonomy.</p>
