Contents	<p>What is cultural history? The course aims to provide students with the tools to orient themselves with respect to the themes and methods of cultural history. The first part of the course will be dedicated to an introduction to international historiography and to research themes; with a specific in-depth study dedicated to the relationship between history and memory, between history and media, between professional history and popular history in the contemporary age. The second part of the course will be dedicated to specific case studies, with individual and group exercises and workshops. The aim of the second part of the course is to confront directly with the problems of historical research on contested, divided and removed memories.</p>
