Syllabus	
Prerequisite requirements	Basic contents of Social Psychology
Expected learning outcomes	<p><i>Knowledge and understanding</i> This course aims at giving knowledge and understanding of basic notions in group psychology according to a psychosocial perspective.</p> <p><i>Applying knowledge and understanding</i> Psychosocial dynamics in daily life of small and large groups will be analyzed. Theoretical and methodological discussion will enable students to employ assimilated knowledges even in not directly examined contexts.</p> <p><i>Making informed judgements and choices</i> This course aims at developing understanding of different social groups' data in an autonomous way, in order to identify dynamics, functions and solutions.</p> <p><i>Communicating knowledge and understanding</i> Another aim is to promote the ability of communicating theoretical and methodological deductions about different social groups.</p> <p><i>Capacities to continue learning</i></p>

	Learning skills consist of improving theoretical and practical contents by independently deepening them.
Contents	<p>This course will be composed of two modules: the first and general module deals with some conceptual contributions of social psychology; the second and specific module deals with historical, theoretical and methodological contents of group psychology.</p> <p>In the first module, some emblematic research studies in social psychology are described as the basis for the explanation of social and group interaction.</p> <p>In the second module, group dynamics such as status, roles, norms, leadership, communication, influence, and members' experiences such as admission, socialization, belonging sense, participation and going out, are discussed.</p>
