Course program	Particular attention will be placed on the role played by the environment in the learning process, with reference to the key concepts of the socio-cultural perspective. Will explain the various methods of organization and management of some of the main lessons / learning techniques such as the lesson and the collaborative learning models. In particular, the educational psychology will be discussed as an intersubjective process based on the speech and action. In addition it reviews the various models of community both in face to face environments in virtual environments. Compared to the latter will be explored the possibilities of designing learning paths with the support offered by the technology.
