Contents

The course will address themes of specific social and cultural interest in the Hispanic and Hispanic-American world, specially if expressed and conveyed through cinematographic works.

The study methodology will therefore be interdisciplinary (sociological, historical, psychological, artistic) but it will have as its common ground the analysis of film language and film narrative as a means of expression and communication of important cultural issues in the Spanish-speaking countries. The main theme will be the relationship between cinema and memory, with particular reference to memory and the testimony of traumatic events in contemporary history.
