DECREES

For the 2017-2018 Academic Year, admissions for the "Summer Training on Assisted Reproductive Technologies with Germ cells of Animal ModEls (START GAME)", are hereby initiated by the Department of *Biosciences*, Biotechnologies and Biopharmaceutics, in cooperation with MARIO LIPPOLIS Strumentazione Scientifica (Gioia del Colle -Bari).

1. Objectives, aims and organization

Information regarding the aims, employment prospects, number of available posts, qualifications required for entry, selection procedures, organization of instruction, enrollment fees, and any other specific instructions referring to the Summer School is contained in the form attached to this Decree, of which it constitutes an integral part.

2. Requirements for admission

The Summer School is open to 20 participants, namely Bachelor degree students, Master's degree students, PhD students and Post Doctoral researchers. The applicant must possess the necessary qualifications at the time of submission of the application for admission in order for it to be valid. The Scientific Technical Committee of the Summer School is responsible for deciding whether to recognise qualifications obtained abroad, exclusively for the purpose of enrolment in the Course. An adequate level of English proficiency is required (Lev B2).

3. Terms and conditions for submitting applications for admission

Applications for admission must be submitted by June 30th2018.

To apply, the candidates should:

1. connect to the University website at <u>www.uniba.it</u>; go to the bottom of the page and click on the "Esse3 Segreteria on line" button or go directly to http://www.studenti.ict.uniba.it/esse3/Home.do);

2. log in with username and password (if already registered) or register as a new user; do this by pressing "Login" or "registrarsi" in the following sentences:

3. select (on the left) Segreteria > ADMISSIONS (CONCORSI TEST DI AMMISSIONE) > START GAME, and follow the instructions to complete the application for admission;

5. before 30 June 2018, send the Program Director (<u>mariaelena.dellaquila@uniba.it</u>) by email a curriculum vitae, any qualifications relevant to the evaluation of the application for admission and a brief text (500 words) outlining their interest in participating ("motivation statement").

Candidates who have omitted any of the supporting documents requested in the public announcement, or who have made false statements regarding their status, or falsifications in the documentation attached to their applications for admission, will be excluded from participating in the selection process and from attending the Program, subject to the penalties set forth in art. 76 of DPR no. 445 of 28.12.2000. Pursuant to art. 40 of DPR no. 445/2000, as amended by art. 15 of Law no. 183/2011, certificates and personal documents may be replaced by declaration that you have obtained the qualification, as referred to in articles 46 and 47 of the same decree.

FOREIGN STUDENTS.











Non-Italian citizens of the European Union (regardless of where they reside), non-EU citizens who are legal residents of Italy, and non-EU citizens who reside abroad are eligible to apply. These students must complete the application for admission and send the Program Director by email (mariaelena.dellaquila@uniba.it) copies of degrees issued by foreign institutions, accompanied by a translation into English or Italian. For travel expenses and accomodation the University of Bari will reimburse a sum of Euro 200- to the top five (n. 5) participants not resident in Italy, as ranked by the Examination Commission.

4. Examination Commission

The Examination Commission for admission to the Summer School will be appointed by Decree of the Director of the Department of *Biosciences*, Biotechnologies and Biopharmaceutics.

5. Selection Procedure

The ranking procedure for selection of participants and for reimbursement of foreign students will be carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions set out by the Evaluation Committee. In case of equal points, the place will be awarded on a first-come first-served basis of the date and time of the application.

6. Approval of acts

The ranking list of candidates admitted to enrolment will be published on the website http://www.uniba.it/didattica on the page dedicated to the Summer School as official communication to the interested parties. Admitted participants will not be contacted individually.

7. Enrollment of accepted students

Successful applicants will have to accept the scholarship within the deadline communicated by the University of Bari Aldo Moro at the time that the rankings are posted, and email to Dr. Mrs Antonella Novelli (antonella.novelli@uniba.it), Officer responsible for the administrative procedure, the following documentation:

- Acceptance declaration;
- photocopy of a valid identification document;
- photocopy of the applicant's fiscal code (only for Italian participants);
- curriculum vitae.

Costs of the Summer School are financed by Cohesion Action Plan funds -agreed with the European Commission - and by Mario Lippolis Strumentazione Scientifica.

Participants are required to pay for the registration fee (stamp duty Euro 16,00) and the insurance contribution of Euro 4,13 by the expiration date published on the Course web page, linking to "Esse3 online Secretary" and following the procedure indicated in the REGISTRATION section, and then the PAYMENTS section.

In case of withdrawal without adequate reason (as determined by the Program Director) after enrolment, participants are requested to return the cost of the study grant (Euro 400-) offered by the European Commission and managed by Apulia Region and MARIO LIPPOLIS Strumentazione Scientifica.











8. Attendance, renunciation, awarding of diploma

Attendance: The student is required to attend at least 80% of the planned educational activities. No suspension or interruption of the coursework is possible.

Withdrawal by the student, lack of attendance or absence from greater than 20% of the planned educational activities for any reason, will result in the revocation of the ability to obtain a diploma.

Awarding of diploma: At the end of the course, the attendance certificate will be awarded to students who have attended at least 80% of the educational activities.

OBJECTIVES AND ORGANIZATION OF THE SUMMER SCHOOL

The START-GAME Summer School aims to provide theoretical and practical skills in Assisted Reproductive Technologies and to encourage those people interested in working in this area to embark on a learning path by using animal gametes and embryos from models, such as cattle, sheep, and horses, of recognized translational relevance for human reproductive medicine. After starting by studying reproductive physiology in human and domestic animal species, the set of technologies of assisted reproduction will be presented: in vitro oocyte maturation, sperm cell selection and in vitro capacitation, in vitro fertilization, pre-implantation embryo development and quality assessment methods for gametes and embryos. The course will be taught by professors from the University of Bari and other universities, and by professionals working in Assisted Reproduction, all of them with proven experience in the field. The course will provide students a unique opportunity to carry out practical activities with animal cell systems under the guidance of specialists. The acquired skills may be used in Italy and abroad in public or private Health facilities of Assisted Reproduction, both in the human and veterinary field, and in research











institutions. Moreover, since the in vitro methods and animal models presented have been validated or are under validation by the European Agency for Validation of Alternative Methods to Animal Experimentation (ECVAM), acquired skills may also be used in laboratories of reproductive toxicology for evaluation of pharmaceutical, cosmetic, food, hygiene and other commonly used products.

The course will cover the development of the complete cycle of activities aimed at in vitro production of embryos in animal models. In detail, the sequence of techniques for collection, evaluation, micromanipulation and culture of animal gametes for the purpose of obtaining pre-implantation embryos will be illustrated with a theoretical-practical approach.

The course will be in Italian and English; translation will be provided for some aspects as needed.

ACTIVITIES

The activities will take place at the Department of Biosciences, Biotechnologies and Biopharmaceutics (DBBB), Labo-Biotech, via Giuseppe Fanelli n. 204, 70125, Bari and at the Animal Reproduction Biotechnology laboratories (DBBB), Str. Prov. Casamassima Km 3, 70010, Polo di Valenzano, Bari. Lectures will be held in classrooms by professors. Laboratory activities, given the requirement for simultaneous use of instruments located in different laboratories in the abovementioned institutions, will be carried out some in Bari and some in Valenzano, under the guidance of professors and laboratory tutors. Laboratory tutors will be selected by public call.

The course will take place from **Monday 17 to Thursday 20 September 2018**, specifically in 4 days with 8 contact hours each day. Each day there will be 4 hours in the morning for lectures and 4 hours in the afternoon for practical laboratory activities

On Tuesday Sept 18th the Mario Lippolis company will contribute to a demonstration at Labo-Biotech, University of Bari, in relation with the topic of the program. The company will present a set of innovative instruments for sperm quality evaluation. For this event, instruments and specialists (at least two) will be made available by the company to demonstrate their applications.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS: Italian or foreign Master's degree graduates or those with equivalent qualifications obtained abroad; or researchers, post-docs or PhD students, interested in Assisted Reproduction, both in human and veterinary medicine. Non-graduated students, enrolled in bachelor or Master degree programs, are also eligible. Non-graduated people, with high school diplomas, may be admitted only in case they are or have been employed in Assisted Reproduction centres in the human or veterinary field. This employment qualification needs to be certified by the institution, with the duration of employment indicated. Equivalence of qualifications obtained abroad will be certified by the project coordinator. Preferred requirements are: Master degree, post-graduate training courses and PhD in the area of the course, together with knowledge of the English language at a minimum level of B2.
