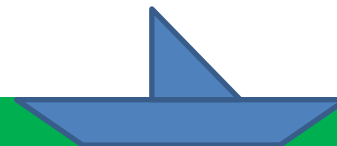

Summer School in Safety, Navigation and Environment VASCO DA GAMA Objectives

The Summer School aims to:

- set up and develop an innovative educational project on Multimodal Carriage (especially the maritime one), Port Logistics and environmental challenges from which the maritime entrepreneurs may benefit;
- foster young people being willing either of a professional characterization or to improve their own technical knowledge;
