Addendum to the 'The Partnership Agreement of the new consortium of 9 partners' as signed by the 9 EGEI partners in 2011

Preamble

The EGEI consortium partners agree that the Universiteit Antwerpen (Belgium), the Staffordshire University (UK) and the Universidade de Brasilia (Brazil) are no longer part of the consortium at the end of the academic year 2017-2018, i.e. from 1 November 2018. The composition of the consortium for the academic year 2019- 2020 is the following one:

- Vysoká škola ekonomická v Praze (Czech Republic), coordinator,
- Università degli Studi di Bari 'Aldo Moro' (Italy),
- Vrije Universiteit Brussel (Belgium),
- Universidad de Cantabria (Spain),
- Université de Lille (France),
- Xiamen University (P.R. China)

1. Article 10 of the partnership agreement shall be supplemented by the following sentence: The new EGEI consortium partners extend the partnership agreement for the duration of the academic year 2019-2020, that is from September 1st 2019 till October 31st, 2020.

2. Article 4 of the partnership agreement shall be supplemented by the following sentence: A Board of Directors (BD) is elected by the Joint Board of Studies, and consists of 4 representatives of the partner universities. It is in charge of the day-to-day operation of the Programme and co-ordinates the actions decided upon by the Joint Board of Studies. The activities of the Board of Directors are organized along three different functions – Programme coordination, Academic coordination and Course coordination - to which at least one Director is assigned.

3. For the academic year 2019/20, the organizational tasks of the EGEI consortium are allocated across the partners in the following ways:

- Vysoká škola ekonomická v Praze (Czech Republic): organization of classes in the third term, preparation and delivery of diploma, administrative coordination of the program, lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee,
- Université de Lille (France): lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee,
- Università degli Studi di Bari 'Aldo Moro' (Italy): organization of classes in the second term, lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee,
- Vrije Universiteit Brussel (Belgium): lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee.
- Universidad de Cantabria (Spain): lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee,

- Xiamen University (P.R. China): organization of classes in the first term, lecturing in the master program, participation in steering- and selection committee.

Students can enroll at Università degli Studi di Bari 'Aldo Moro' (Italy), Universidad de Cantabria (Spain), Université de Lille (France), Vysoká škola ekonomická v Praze (Czech Republic), and Xiamen University (P.R. China). For the academic year 2019/20, students will only pay tuition fees at their home University.
