### OBIETTIVI E ORGANIZZAZIONE DEL CORSO

#### OBIETTIVI

The course is meant to emphasize the Mediterranean context in which it is geographically, located, with the ambition to work as a 'bridge' between Middle East and Africa, on the one hand, and Europe, on the other. The multidisciplinary connotation of this course is oriented to the analysis of the relationships among the cultures that face the Mediterranean sea and the problems of economic development and political relations that concern this context.

The acquisition and application of knowledge, using only the English language, in the named areas will allow the students to master the main lines of a global society in which individuals, states, international organizations, ONG and enterprises are going through a process of reorganization – each in its own way – to tackle important challenges and not miss new opportunities. Our didactic plan will be oriented to the finality of forming specialists that can work on various levels – e.g. political, economic, cultural, etc. – particularly in the Mediterranean area, among the specific cultures that belong to it.

A special added value to the Master programme will be provided by the international agreements with European universities that already offer a PPE master course. We shall share with them competences and experiences, exchanging staff and students to provide the best possible learning in the interdisciplinary field of PPE. Our students will enjoy the opportunity of spending at least one semester abroad and credits taken there will be counted toward our degree. Viceversa, we shall offer the same opportunity to foreign students coming with the following universities. Agreements in progress are with Bayreuth University (Germany), Witten/Herdecke University (Germany), National Research University Higher School of Economics, Moscow (Russia), Uppsala University (Sweden). At a second stage we shall join a group of PPE programmes including Graz University (Austria), Bern University (Switzerland) and Bochum University (Germany).

Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) brings together some of the most important approaches to understanding the world around us, developing skills useful for a whole range of careers and activities.

Studying Philosophy, students will develop analytical rigour and the ability to criticise and reason logically, and be able to apply these skills to questions concerning how we acquire knowledge or make ethical judgements. The study of Politics provides a thorough understanding of the impact of political institutions on modern societies. It helps the students to evaluate the choices that political systems must regularly make, to explain the processes that maintain or change those systems, and to examine the concepts and values used in political analysis. Economics is the study of how consumers, firms and government make decisions that together determine how resources are allocated. An appreciation of economics has become increasingly necessary to make sense of governmental policy-making, the conduct of businesses, and the enormous economic transformations throughout the world.

PPE offers a good preparation for a wide variety of careers, many linked to subjects studied at Oxford. The careers most commonly chosen are in: Banking and finance, politics, journalism and broadcasting, law, industry, teaching, social work, accountancy, business management, advertising, many branches of the public service, including the civil and diplomatic services and local government.
