Contents	This course will be composed of two modules: the first and general module deals with some conceptual contributions of social psychology; the second and specific module deals with historical, theoretical and methodological contents of group psychology. In the first module, some emblematic research studies in social psychology are described as the basis for the explanation of social and group interaction. In the second module, group dynamics such as status, roles, norms, leadership, communication, influence, and members' experiences such as admission, socialization, belonging sense, participation and going out, are discussed.
