

WRITTEN EXAM – INSTRUCTIONS (PART III) (This file contains 2 pages)

The written exam comprises the following sections/exercises:

- A1. Reading Comprehension (a text + 1 open questions about it)
- A2. Composition
- B (Grammar exercises: Reformulation + Verb Tenses)
- C (an English text to be translated into Italian) (5 lines + the title)
- D (an Italian text to be translated into English) (5 lines + the title)

Each exercise is assigned a score:

- A1= from 0 to 10;
- A2=from 0 to 20;
- B= from 0 to 10;
- C=from 0 to 15;
- D=from 0 to 15.

-If you are a 1a lingua student or 2a lingua student or an Erasmus student who masters Italian well, you are invited to complete all the 5 sections/exercises.

The lowest score/mark to pass the written test is 42 out of 70 (it equals 18/30).

-If you are a 1a lingua student or 2a lingua student who does not master Italian very well, you are invited to complete all the 5 sections/exercises.

-If you are an **Erasmus student** who does NOT master Italian very well, you are invited to complete exercises n. A1, A2, B, D. (You are not obliged to translate the English text into Italian, C). Your written exam lasts 3 hours.

The lowest score to pass the written test is 33 out of 55 (it equals 18/30).


- **3a lingua LCT students** are only requested to complete Exercise A1, B, and C. The written exam for 3a lingua LCT students lasts 2 hours.

The lowest score to pass the written test is 21 out of 35 (it equals 18/30)


PLEASE, REMEMBER:

-If we find **identical answers** (whether they are in the section A1 or A2 or C or D), the score will be 0 (zero) for each identical section.

-If we find **semi-identical/similar answers**, which we can prove they are definitely copied from one another, the score will be around from 1 to 3.



- I DO NOT APPROVE OF BULLYING: Do NOT ask any of your classmates to give you the answers to the exercises. Avoid asking them and by offending them.
