Syllabus	
Learning Objectives	The first objective is related on the basic knowledge of glossary of the sociology of education. The course is focalized on the ability to understand the main sociological terms applied to education and culture, specially in relation on the new-emergencies (war, pandemic, crisis). The second learning objective will be defining a knowledge about the educational processes (theoretical framework and methodological tools)
Course prerequisites	Being able to use the glossary of sociology of education and toapply the main theoretical tools to understand the relation between education and society.
Contents	The course will start with an introduction on Sociology of Education as social science, with specific attention to its specific field of study and the main theoretical sociological paradigms. The first part of the course will be dedicated to the main theoretical instruments developed by the sociological science for analysing educational and teaching processes. General theories, theoretical models and concepts will be used in order to look at the main results of sociological research about educational systems (formal, informal, non-formal). In the second part of the course will be dedicated to the themes of socialization, learning and identity building within the sociological research about social inequality in education and teaching, social and intercultural dynamics and migration, education in emergency. In the final part of course it will be work in a formative evaluationand assessment field to verify and to collect the feedback from students about the learning outcomes of sociology of education.
