Knowledge of fragility and family resources. . <i>Knowledge and understanding skills applied</i> The ability to apply the acquired knowledge and research methodologies also to contexts different from those examined in class and to other scientific and social sectors. . <i>Autonomy of judgment</i> The ability to analyze contexts and family relationships independently using critical bibliographic tools and to express appropriate evaluations to the historical-cultural-social context of contemporary families . <i>Communication skills</i> The ability to describe and interpret, through the use of appropriate terminology, the familiar social and social contexts and to transfer their knowledge to expert and non-expert interlocutors in the disciplinary field. . <i>Ability to learn</i> The ability to critically manage the specific bibliography and the essential tools of the research, and to apply them to areas of investigation not examined in class.
