Designing authentic transnational projects

More than organizations from different countries being involved in a partnership

- Focus on joint challenges that go beyond national borders
- Developing and applying common answers
- Sharing of expertise to create impactful better solutions

Positive impact across territories

- Ensure that projects deliver significant benefits in all involved regions, avoiding a sole North-South perspective
- Avoid concentration of pilot activities in specific areas; adapt methodologies to local scales and needs

Cooperation as the engine of projects

- Joint Development: Integrating ideas, expectations, and contributions from all partners to ensure shared understanding and commitment to project goals.
- Joint Implementation: Balanced task distribution among partners, each playing a crucial role in project activities, management, reporting, and monitoring.
- Joint Financing and Staffing: Shared project budget with co-financing from all partners, and collaborative staffing with tasks divided for coordinated execution.











Delivering Tangible Benefits Through Interreg NEXT MED Projects

- Focus on Real-world Impact: Projects must address and solve real issues, improving situations at a pilot scale for effective outcomes.
- Beyond Discussions and Exchanges: Projects should transcend mere dialogue among partners and experts, evolving into open communities with increased community impact.
- Benefiting the End-users: Ensure that project outcomes positively affect the final beneficiaries by providing opportunities, meeting their needs, and enhancing their well-being.











Interreg NEXT MED: a framework for action

- Implementation Beyond Guidelines: Projects should extend beyond developing guidelines, action plans, models, and strategies, and focus on their practical application.
- Pilot Testing as a Priority: Emphasize the importance of testing and applying these tools and strategies at a pilot scale within the project timeline.
- **Demonstrating Validity through Action:** The actual implementation and testing of project outputs are crucial for demonstrating their effectiveness and real-world applicability.











Ensuring Long-Term Legacy

- Project as a Catalyst: Treat the project as a "seed fund" to create an enabling ecosystem and initiate lasting positive change at the territorial level.
- Continuity Strategies: Include transfer of infrastructure management, continuation of key activities, seeking additional funding, and integrating successful practices into the toolbox of public authorities, stakeholders, and communities.
