

Dr Katherine E Brown is a Reader in Religion and Global Security at the University of Birmingham, UK and visiting professor at the University of Bari, Aldo Moro, Italy. Her research examines the role of gender in Islamist extremism and counter terrorism. This is the focus of her book *Gender, Religion, Extremism* (Oxford University Press, 2020). Her policy work addresses gender and human rights mainstreaming in preventing and countering extremism. She is also the lead researcher on the AHRC "Humanities for Resilience" network project which brings together academics, activists, artists, and others to advance the creative and narrative contributions of the arts and humanities to societal and community resilience. She teaches about religious nationalism; global Islam; the politics of the Middle East; and gender, sexualities and religion.
