Applications

To be eligible to apply, you will need a university/college or substantial management experience. Candidates should apply via the website. Two references and a CV will be required. At the second stage of the process, candidates will be interviewed by the Programme Director and another member of staff. This rigorous selection process is to ensure that the Programme is right for you, and vice versa. Class sizes are limited to around 25 delegates in order to maximise interaction and to tailor sessions to group interests. Thus, although there is no official closing date for applications, you are advised to apply early.
