b. attivare/potenziare il servizio di Counseling psicologico, attraverso la predisposizione di una "resting room" per studenti in situazioni critiche o in difficoltà occasionale". L'area, accessibile per cinque giorni alla settimana, destinata alla realizzazione dell'equilibrio tra studio e benessere psico-fisico degli studenti e del personale universitario, dovrà essere dotata di elementi di arredo confortevole, atti a favorire una situazione di calma e sollievo dalle tensioni.

I Dipartimenti, sui quali dovranno gravare gli oneri di manutenzione, sgombero e pulizia degli spazi, nonché dell'arredamento richiesto per ciascuno di essi, sono stati invitati a comunicare la disponibilità dei suddetti spazi e dei budget a ciò destinati, entro il 24 giugno p.v., alla UO Servizio Counseling Psicologico Studenti dell'Ateneo, che valuterà le proposte ed effettuerà successivi controlli.

Gli studenti intervenuti, anche a nome delle liste da essi rappresentate, chiedono che il Dipartimento si attivi per la realizzazione degli interventi su richiamati.

Interviene la prof. Cotecchia la quale, sottolineando gli sforzi compiuti da tutto il Dipartimento per offrire il miglior servizio possibile agli studenti nonostante le enormi carenze di risorse economiche e logistiche, invita gli studenti ad essere coscienti, critici e costruttivi per poter essere sempre di stimolo e contribuire al mantenimento di standard qualitativo dei servizi didattici elevati.

***fellowships with industrial characterization between***

and

**the Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen**, with offices Krankenhausstraße 12, 91054 Erlangen, Germany, VAT Number 248558812 legally represented by Prof. Dr. Robert Grützmann in the capacity as head of Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikum Erlangen herein after with the Parties,

GIVEN

- the University Regulations on research fellowships, issued with D.R. n. 1154 of 19.04.2018
- the Notice issued with the D.D. MIUR n. 1090 of 04.05.2018 concerning the "Innovative research fellowships with industrial characterization" in the National Operational Program FSE-ERDF Research and Innovation 2014 - 2020, Axis I - Investments in Human Capital, Action I.1
- that the D.D. 2983 of 5 November 2018, annexes C and D, following the results of the assessments carried out by ANVUR, in relation to the Notice





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- "Innovative doctorates with industrial characterization" XXXIV cycle, the project proposals presented were approved, but not financed due to the inability of the financial endowment;
- the D.D. n. 1747 of 13.09.2019 "Notice of Expression of Interest" which provided for the funding of PhD scholarships in addition to those funded by universities with other methods for the academic year 2019/2020 - Cycle XXXV, referred to in the project proposals approved with D.D. 2983 of 5 November 2018 (Attachments C and D) in the context of the PON "Research and Innovation" 2014-2020 and the POC "Research and Innovation" 2014-2020, "Innovative PhDs with industrial characterization";
  - in particular, article 1 of the aforementioned Notice which provides for periods of study and research in companies based in Italy, as well as periods of study and research at foreign hosts from a minimum of six months to a maximum of eighteen months;
  - the project proposal presented by the University of Bari Aldo Moro as part of the before mentioned notice (attachment A);
  - the DD.DD. MIUR n. 2008 of 22.10.2019 and n. 2162 of 07.11.2009 that approve and amend the ranking and admission to the funding of the project proposals concerning the additional scholarships with the related amount funded by PON R&I 2014-2020 Axis I - Action I.1 and POC R&I 2014-2020 Axis I - Action I.1;
  - the Procedural Guidelines governing the management, implementation, obligations, reporting of activities and payment methods to the Universities eligible for the funding of additional research fellowship scholarships related



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to the XXXV cycle;

- in particular, article 3, paragraph 6, of the aforementioned Procedural Guidelines which, additionally, states: *"The research fellow beneficiary must write every two months a report on the activities carried out. In particular by electronic means on the on-line platform <http://dottorati.miur.it> and on the forms prepared by the MIUR each PhD fellow beneficiary of the additional POC RI 2014-2020 grant, must produce a report indicating the time commitment (divided into months in the company, at headquarters, abroad) and a summary of the main activities carried out. It will be the responsibility of the Coordinator of the PhD course, to verify and validate on the same on-line platform what is indicated by the student. The report thus validated will form the basis for the calculation by MIUR of the eligible expenses (by applying the standard cost) for the two-month reference period";*
- likewise, article 4 paragraph 1 of the aforementioned Procedural Guidelines which, additionally, governs the hypothesis of the total revocation of the loan, with the consequent restitution of any amounts already paid and includes among the aforesaid hypotheses the *"failure to carry out the minimum period of study and research in a company and/or abroad;"* and *"non-compliance with national and/or EU laws, including the rules on information and communication of (EU) Regulation no. 1303/2013, Annex XII, section 2.2 "Responsibilities of beneficiaries.";*
- in addition, article 6 of the same Procedural Guidelines which states: *"The*



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MIUR may carry out checks at any time (including through subjects it appoints in accordance with Community regulations and implemented in the Program Management and Control System) to ascertain the correct execution of the project.

Each proposing subject is obliged to guarantee the MIUR that these controls will be carried out in all the places involved in the project, *even if external to the University premises, making available all the required documentation; for this purpose; every University is obliged to ensure that this requirement is complied with even by the Italian and foreign companies and/or universities involved in the project.*

*Finally, if the documentation produced and the verifications and controls carried out verify the existence of illegitimate situations or serious breaches of the obligations referred to in these Procedural Guidelines emerge, or the occurrence of causes of inadmissibility for the granting of the financing of additional grants, the MIUR will proceed with the revocation of the contribution, providing for the recovery of the sums already accredited.”;*

- MIUR note n. 3381 of 20.12.2018 concerning the total or partial revocation due to failure to carry out the minimum period of study and research in the company and/or abroad;
- the Operational Guidelines for beneficiaries by the Managing Authority of the PON for Research and Innovation 2014-2020;
- the Guidelines for information and publicity actions by the Managing Authority of the PON for Research and Innovation 2014-2020;



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- D.R. n. 2659 of 24/08/2021 assigns the research fellowship grant with industrial characterization, funded by POC R&I 2014-2020, to Dr. Daria Di Molfetta to attend the PhD in “Genomics and proteomics functional and applied” (XXXV Cycle) with administrative headquarters at the University of Bari Aldo Moro - Department of Biosciences, Biotechnologies and Biopharmaceutics , CUP: H95E19000260006;
- the declaration of availability of Dr. Daria Di Molfetta to carry out periods of research (minimum 6 months, maximum 18 months) in active enterprises that carry out economic activities consistent with the areas and development trajectories of the SNSI and periods of study and research abroad for the period envisaged by the research doctorate (minimum 6 months, maximum 18 months) as provided by the University in the presented project proposal;
- the MIUR circular prot. n. 10325 of 26.06.2020 (Smartworking Epidemiological emergency from COVID-19) which states that "all periods of activity (headquarters / company / abroad) carried out by doctoral students in the distance-learning mode are recognized and accountable" and that "in the event of activities carried out by distant learning, in digital-learning, webinar-based mode, in collaboration with the foreign institution but physically from Italy / the Italian University headquarters, the Italian Standard Cost Unit will be associated with this period without counting the foreign surcharge"



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## AGREE UPON THE FOLLOWING

### Art.1

The premises are an integral part of this agreement.

The Parties agree to cooperate for the realization of the project called "Development of a technological platform for the bioengineered reconstruction of preclinical models of human adenopancreatic tumor" with the procedures envisaged in the project proposal and in compliance with all the documents, referred to in the preamble, which govern the implementation of the project itself.

In particular, the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** undertakes to host Dr.Daria Di Molfetta, holder of the scholarship referred to in the preamble, to carry out the research activity titled "Development of a technological platform for the bioengineered reconstruction of preclinical models of human adenopancreatic tumor" for 6 months, as per the approved project, in its own laboratory at the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** located at Krankenhausstraße 12 91054 Erlangen, Germany

The **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** also undertakes to support the research of the research fellow beneficiary of the additional grant by allowing access to the equipment as well as to the laboratories necessary for carrying out the research activities. Furthermore, the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** undertakes to carry out training activities aimed at enriching the personal and professional knowledge of the research fellow.



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The **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** undertakes to guarantee to MIUR the carrying out of verifications in all the locations involved in the project, making available all the required documentation.

Art.3

The period spent at **the Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** by Dr. Daria Di Molfetta does not constitute a working relationship, therefore, the research fellow cannot be assigned to tasks other than those agreed upon nor to productive functions beyond those strictly necessary for the pursuit of the objectives envisaged by the project; furthermore, it does not imply any present or future commitment of employment by **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen**.



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#### Art. 4

During his stay at the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** the research fellow will pay no fee to the University, nor will the University make any kind of payment to the scholarship winner. Furthermore, no compensation will be requested from the University and/or the research fellow.

#### Art. 5

During the activities in the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen** coordinator and tutor will be in constant contact with the persons in the University supervising the project activities and with the research fellow, also for the purpose of completing the daily register of the activities of the research fellow, beneficiary of the additional POC RI 2014- 2020 grant.

#### Art. 6

The research fellow is required to sign a commitment to confidentiality and recognition of intellectual property rights in relation to information, data and documents of a confidential nature, which he could become aware of when carrying out his activity at the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen**. In any case, the research fellow is guaranteed the possibility to carry out the ordinary publication activities called for in the training course, which must be programmed in a manner compatible with the protection of any results.

All the products and instruments created, as well as the data and results, will



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be the property of the authors.

The University reserves the right to use the above-mentioned products, instruments, data and results for the purposes of communication and dissemination of the activities carried out within the framework of the POC RI 2014-2020.

The use of any inventions created within the scope of the activities covered by this agreement and of which the University is owner or co-owner will be governed by specific and separate agreements, in compliance with the applicable laws on intellectual property and rules concerning administrative procedure.

The scholarship holder and the personnel of the Parties involved for the realization of the collaboration referred to in this agreement are required to maintain the necessary confidentiality as regards data, information or knowledge regarding production processes and products acquired during the course of the research/training activity in question, without prejudice to the communication and publicity obligations set forth in the Implementation Guidelines for innovative research fellowships with industrial characterization under the Research and Innovation 2014-2020 POC, which the parties declare to know and commit themselves to respect.

In any case, the confidentiality of the final dissertation of the scholarship holder is excluded, except for the eventual removal or possible withholding of parts of the dissertation itself that may contain information that, due to its





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nature or purpose, is destined to remain confidential, in compliance with the confidentiality commitments referred to in paragraph 1. All scientific publications deriving from the research fellow's scholarship must contain a reference to the institutions involved.

#### Art. 7

During the period at the **Chirurgische Klinik des Universitätsklinikums Erlangen**, the research fellow will have to: carry out the activities provided for in the project, observe the timetables, the internal regulations, and the rules on hygiene, safety and health in the workplace.

Furthermore, the research fellow will have to comply fully with all the provisions contained in the documents referred to in the premises and in the other provisions and/or indications that will be provided by the Ministry regarding additional scholarships valid for the 35th cycle.

#### Art. 8
