Syllabus	
Learning Objectives	Students must be able to know the problems concerning the trade of livestock and pets, the civil and criminal aspects and the contractual and extra-contractual liability that can arise in the profession. The veterinary prescription and the rules on the veterinary drug. Stray dogs, animal experimentation, animal welfare and its evaluation. The shelters and sanitary kennels. Safety at work. Informed consent and ethical code.
Course prerequisites	Parasitology, Infectious Diseases I, Semeiotics and Medical Pathology. The students must have acquired knowledge and skills relating to the main acquired or genetic pathologies, dispute in buy and sell animals.
Contents	The contents provided to students pertain to the professional training area. Veterinary medicine and public health: History of Legal veterinary medicine. Legislative function, the sources of law. Veterinarian and civil law: Contractual and non-contractual liability. Trade, the promise of sale, identification of the animal, warranty, defect, absence of quality, aliud pro alio, permitted actions (contract termination, actio redibitoria, action quanti minoris, eviction, warranty exclusion). Animal Legal status. Contend in civil law. Office and party consultant. Veterinarian criminal and administrative law. Bribery. International veterinary organizations. Veterinary legislation in animal health, hygiene of farms and livestock production. Zootechnical pollution, production and sale of feed. Ministerial Decree 16.05.2001, n. 306. Legislative Decree 6.04.2006, n. 193: European Community Code of Veterinary Medicines. Animal protection and welfare: purpose, supervision and inspection, Penal Code reforme following the low 189/2004: mistreatment of animals. Low 281/1991: stray prevention. Animal testing: Legislative Decree n. 26/2014. Veterinary profession and the law: registration in the professional register. Waste disposal. The code of ethics. Informed consent. Health and safety protection in veterinary facilities: Legislative Decree 81/2008. Welfare and assistance for veterinarians (ENPAV).
