On behalf of ECOVE, who met on 11 December 2023, I herewith inform you of the evaluation result based on the ESEVT Full Visitation to your VEE on 16 - 20 October 2023.

The Committee further concluded that two Minor Deficiencies had been found.

In accordance with the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT) and based on the educational requirements of the Directive 2005/36/EC as amended by Directive 2013/55/EU,

the status of the VEE of the University of Bari Aldo Moro is ACCREDITATION

In line with the <u>ESEVT SOP 2019</u> as amended in <u>September 2021</u>, under which the visitation was completed, the status will be valid for seven years from the date of the visitation, i.e. until the **end** of October 2030.

This IR should focus solely on the progress in the correction of the Minor Deficiencies.

Two more IRs (3 years and 5 years after the Full Visitation) are to be submitted in October 2026 and October 2028 respectively, in accordance with the new IR procedures under SOP 2023 (for reference please check section 4, Chapter 2 and Annex 14 of the SOP).
