Examinations will be appropriate for each curriculum and the resulting graded lists will converge in a single final list for the admissions to the PhD Course. All positions available in each curriculum will be covered even by successful candidates applying for different curricula in the case of lack of winners in a specific curriculum, with respect to the graded list. Candidates must complete the application form (A) and indicate the curriculum that they choose, pending their exclusion from the competition.

Arrangements for admission:**Selection by titles, written exam and oral exam**

The selection process will include the evaluation of the titles, written and oral exams as well as a verification of the knowledge of the English language.
