BARI AND ITS UNIVERSITY



The University of Bari, established in 1925 starting from the ancient schools of Pharmacy and Notaries, has grown to the present day. Since 2009 it is named after Aldo Moro, a student and teacher of our University. The University of Bari Aldo Moro is the oldest and largest among the Apulian universities, it has a number of students enrolled among the highest in Italy and has structures in the cities of Taranto and Brindisi. The University is composed of 23 departments and 2 schools with a wide range educational offer, research doctorates (Ph.D), specialization schools and I and II level masters. The



reception, understood as a willingness to dialogue and the provision of services, is a strong point of the University's policy. It intervenes by also providing refectories and accommodation for students. There are more and more forms of reward and incentive put in place for the most deserving and needy students. The University is located in different plexuses in the city hosting the activities of the scientific departments and the administration. The main office, a few meters from the train station and the main city streets, is located in a square of buildings that house some departments and that together constitute a real university town in the city center, the Campus Murattiano.

Bari, with its 350,000 inhabitants, overlooks the Adriatic coast and consists of two distinct parts: the old city and the new city. The first part has the characteristic medieval aspect with its main historical and artistic monuments; the new city, whose construction was started in 1813 by the decree of Gioacchino Murat, it develops following a regular chess plan. With the arrival, in 1087, of the relics of San Nicola di Mira, Bari became an important religious center. The Basilica of San Nicola, in the heart of the old city, preserves the relics of the saint who became the patron saint of the city. Bari has a mild climate that, with the many tourist-cultural attractions and beautiful beaches, is a very popular destination and a departure point to important tourist destinations a few kilometers away, such as the UNESCO sites of Alberobello, Castel del Monte, the Sassi of Matera, the baroque of Lecce, or the natural beauties of the Altopiano della Murgia and the coasts of the Gargano and Salento.





SERVICES FOR STUDENTS




The University of Bari offers various services dedicated to its students with the aim of facilitating their university life. In addition to the wide training offer, the strength of the University of Bari is the University librarian system: students can easily do research and can take advantage of libraries and study rooms with wi-fi access and extended opening hours. The Disability Service and specific learning disorders offers personalized advice, ensuring the student the necessary tools to complete the course of study, alongside the Service of psychological help. Furthermore to guarantee a specific support to foreign students there is an advisory desk for the evaluation of qualifications, health care and release of residence permits and visas for international students. Foreign students can refer to the U.O foreign students also to cope with more specific needs.

At the University of Bari there is also the Eurodesk Agency for

information services, promotion and orientation on the programs and opportunities offered from the European Union and the Council of Europe concerning student transnational mobility. The incoming and ongoing Orientation Service accompanies the students along the training way, at the end of which the Placement Agency provides them indications for entering the world of work, with the help of the innovative platform "P.Or.Ti.A.Mo V.A.L.O.R.E", which connects institutions, companies, undergraduates and graduates. The University Sports Center is proud of the University of Bari, with free access for students, which encourages sports politics in the framework of the student's global education with initiation courses at sports practice and specialization (sailing, athletics, canoeing, rowing, karate, swimming, basketball, volleyball, skating, tennis, triathlon and ultimate frisbee). The University of Bari has WebRadio and WebTv, through which the university community tells its story.



Erasmus incoming students from the University of Bari in the last 3 years




